

WASTE MANAGEMENT & SUSTAINABILITY POLICY



VertaseFLI are committed to minimising the sustainability impacts of our activities by utilising our design responsibilities to implement the principles of sustainable remediation.

We shall reduce, re-use and recycle waste wherever possible and adopt management practices to contribute towards sustainable future through:

- Maintaining knowledge of and compliance with sustainability legislation and guidelines.
- Reviewing, monitoring and setting objectives and targets for our sustainability impacts.
- Raising sustainability awareness within the business together with employee competency.
- Implementing the CL:AIRE Definition of Waste Code of Practice principles and industry best practice to ensure that site materials are reused/ recycled whenever possible, thus reducing waste to landfill and in turn resulting in a reduction of traffic to and from sites.
- Supporting local businesses by purchasing products and using suppliers locally wherever practical.
- Working with suppliers/ subcontractors to promote industry waste management best practice.
- Switching off all electrical appliances overnight, minimising the use of fossil fuels and thereby reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- Recycling office printer cartridges and paper.
- Reducing paper consumption by minimising the amount of office printing.
- Disposing of all spent electrical items in accordance with the WEEE Directive.
- Reducing carbon emissions by avoiding physical travel to meetings adopting alternative methods and planning meetings so that multiple trips are avoided, when practicable.
- Regularly auditing and inspecting our activities to ensure compliance with this policy.
